



Penumbral Lunar Eclipse

There will be a penumbral lunar eclipse can witnessing the Sri Lankan on May 26th 2021, where the Vesak Full Moon Poya day. During a lunar eclipse, the moon moves through the earth's shadow because our planet the Earth place directly between the Sun and the Moon. In a total lunar eclipse, the Moon and Sun are directly opposite sides of the Earth and the Moon is completely shrouded in the earth's shadow, whereas a partial lunar eclipse occurs when only a part of the moon moves into Earth's shadow. In Colombo, Sri Lanka, the moon rises at 6:23 p.m. local time on May 26, and the penumbral eclipse ends at 7:19 p.m. local time.
